10.1 Antelope School Principal Report

Tomorrow is the Antelope Christmas Program. The Kindergarten program will begin at 1:00 p.m., First Grade will begin at 1:30 p.m., and Second Grade will begin at 6:00 p.m. All Board members are invited to attend. Due to limited seating the Second Grade program is ticketed. Each student received 4 tickets.

First Trimester awards were held last Friday. Students were recognized for behavior, academics, attendance, and kindness. All students with perfect attendance were eligible to be in the drawing for a bike. Jaden Humphrey was the winner of the bike. All the award recipients are posted on our website.

Antelope 3rd Grade student, Olivia Fambrough, has started a campaign to collect sock and shoes for children in need. She has been featured in the Daily News, and has received support from Salvation Army and Payless Shoes.

Both of the positions have been filled in the Learning Center and it is running a full capacity.

The Site Council has approved both the Antelope and Berrendos School Accountability Report Cards.

10.2 Berrendos School Principals Report

Berrendos has applied for the Gear Up Grant. This grant supports what Berrendos is doing with Expect More Berrendos Movement. It supports middle schools in developing a self-sustaining college-going culture for all students. Gear Up provides a network of support and professional development to integrate a college-going culture into school site reform efforts.

A Wal-Mart grant has been submitted to help defray costs of transportation for college and university visits.

Berrendos has held two collaboration days this year—the first on October 25, 2011 and the second on November 29, 2011. These days have been very beneficial. The teachers have been able to analyze data collection, how to interpret the data, discuss teaching strategies, and how to present the data and assessments to the students.

December 2, 2011 was the Band and fiddle concert. It was well attended. Mrs. Cottier thanked Mrs. Huskey for having the students well prepared.

Berrendos has concluded its fall fundraiser. Total sales so far are \$19,500 the Student Council gets to keep 50% of the sales. Students who sold 10 boxes had their name entered in a drawing to win an IPad. The top 8 sellers will receive a limo ride to In & Out Burger in Redding. The drawing will be held on Friday December 16, 2011.

Superintendent Brose gave a brief update of the Governors press conference regarding mid-year cuts. The triggers imposed will impact the district, approximately \$13 per ADA, and \$40,000 in transportation.

A Special Education parent meeting will be held this Thursday. Mrs. Owens and Mrs. Gallagher will both be available to talk about Special Education student services and answer any questions parents may have. Pizza and daycare will be provided.
