The following discussion by the Board includes both Items 6.1 and 6.2 because they interact with each other.

Mr. Brose opened the discussion for the Administrative Structure for 2014-2015 with the following optional structures that may work for Antelope School District:

OPTION 1:

1 Full-time Superintendent

2 Site Principals: 1 for AES and 1 for BMS with one of the two also serving the Mountain Schools

.5 FTE Lead Teacher/Resource Teacher at Manton School.

Plum Valley Resource Students will bus to Antelope or Berrendos along with the 6th, 7th, and 8th graders to BMS.

The downside of this option is the administration costs will rise with a full-time Superintendent and funding is not going directly to the students. Mrs. Brose does not recommend this option due to the cost.

OPTION 2:

Superintendent/Principal at 1 site in town

1 full-time Principal at the other town site and serving the Mountain Schools

.5 FTE Lead Teacher

.5 Resource Teacher @ Manton School

Plum Valley Resource Students will bus to Antelope or Berrendos along with the 6th, 7th, and 8th graders to BMS.

OPTION 3:

Superintendent/Principal at 1 site in town

1 full-time Principal at the other town site

1 full-time Assistant Principal to serve the Mountain Schools 3 days/week and 2 days/week relieving the Superintendent as needed at either AES or BMS (would not be involved with Site Plans, etc.)

.5 FTE Resource Teacher @ Manton School and working with other small groups

Plum Valley Resource Students will bus to Antelope or Berrendos along with the 6th, 7th, and 8th graders to BMS)

Pupil Services Coordinator would be freed up from Principal Duties to assist with student counselling at the Mountain Schools.

No need for a Lead Teacher

Admin is not tied to tenure

OPTION 4:

This information has not been discussed in length but was brought up by Teacher, Mrs. Worley at Mineral School and discussed at a Site Council Meeting today at Mineral School:

IF, Mineral School isn't able to keep its doors open, due to very low enrollment in 2014/2015, Mrs. Worley and Ms. Vanslavens would be willing to transport the Mineral students to Plum Valley School. In this option, Mrs. Worley and Mrs. Vanslavens would transfer their job assignments to Plum Valley School. This would be a trial plan for one year and the Mineral School Site Council agrees with this plan-of-action.

Mr. Brose requested the Board to choose one of the options so that he can begin to map out the plans and staff assignments for the chosen option.

Board Member, Jamie Hickok likes Option 3 with having admin at the Mountain Schools a few days per week. Administrator would be able to work w/ students also and get to know the students. RSP teacher at Manton could possibly be more flexible depending on her STRS retirement.
