**10. REPORTS**

**10.1 Superintendent’s Report**

**a.) Attendance/Enrollment Report**

Enrollment stands at 763 down 4 from last month - Antelope 457, BMS 234, Manton 42, PV 23, and CDS 7. P2 looks to be about 48 students higher than last year. The District percent of actual attendance for the 7<sup>th</sup> Month was 94.83%.

**b.) Schooldude-Crisis Manager & Maintenance Essentials**

Both Crisis Manger and Maintenance Essentials are in the process of being implemented. The goal is to have both in place for the start of the 2016-2017 school year.

LCAP meetings will be held weekly through mid-June.

SELPA has a new director and the Antelope District will need to work closely with her to help manage the loss of revenue the district will face with the new funding formula for special education. The loss is in the six figure range and will be implemented over the next three years.

Mr. Hassay let the Board know how fortunate the district is to have found someone to fill the music position here at Antelope and Berrendos. Both Lassen View and Richfield have both been unable to fill their vacant music position for the 2016-17 school year.

**10.2 Manton & Plum Valley Elementary School Principal’s Report**

On April 5, 2016 students and Plum Valley and Manton enjoyed a performance by the Missoula Children’s Theatre.

Manton second trimester honor roll will be going on their reward trip to Rare Air in Redding.

Both Manton and Plum Valley have had internet connectivity issues the last few weeks. i-Ready continues to be a struggle because of the connectivity problems.

Manton School recently attended the Small School Science Fair sponsored by the Tehama County Department of Education

### **10.3 Antelope Elementary School Principal's Report**

Students in grades 1-5 attended the "Cowboy Up" character building assembly last week.

The 1<sup>st</sup> grade production assembly "Save the Bees" was held last Thursday, April 14, 2016.

An Art Walk is scheduled to take place during the annual Grandparent's Day celebration on June 3, 2016.

Fifth grade students are scheduled to visit Berrendos on May 25, 2016 for PE testing and orientation.

We are working in conjunction with Red Bluff High School to test our 8<sup>th</sup> grade EL Students for a more successful transition to high school.
