Scholarships will be awarded in the amount of \$250 to \$1,000 as determined by the scholarship committee.

A scholarship committee chosen by the Antelope Berrendos Booster Club will screen and possibly interview the most qualified applicants. Upon request, the applicant shall provide a photograph suitable for publicity.

Scholarships will be made payable to the college chosen and may be used for books, tuition, supplies, or fees. Student must carry at least 12 units. Scholarships must be used during the student's first year out of high school and will not be continued into following years. Evidence of registration must be received prior to the issuance of a check.
